Do you want to be a part of shaping policies and priorities for New York City Public Schools (NYCPS)? **Applications to run for a seat on a Community or Citywide Education Council are now open!**

Members of the 32 Community Education Councils and 4 Citywide Education Councils are advocates for New York City students and families. They help make decisions regarding education in their communities in important ways, including by reviewing educational programs, approving school zoning lines, and making recommendations to improve services to NYCPS students.

Applying is fast and easy: just log in to your NYC Schools Account (NYCSA) at [schoolsaccount.nyc](https://schoolsaccount.nyc.gov) to get started. Once you're there, you can complete your application in 5 to 10 minutes and submit the brief recommended personal statement.

Don't have a NYC Schools Account (NYCSA)? Create your account now at [schoolsaccount.nyc](https://schoolsaccount.nyc.gov); then, contact your school's parent coordinator to complete the process and make sure your children are added to the account.
